

Definitions



An Inning – A completed cycle that gives both players a turn at the table. Only when both players' turns have been completed should an inning be marked.

Defensive Shot - A shot

that is made with the intent of passing one's turn to their opponent.

INTENT is the key word – did they INTEND to pocket a ball

Any shot that is not Offensive – intending to make a ball - is, therefore, a Defensive Shot.
